MISSIONARIES WORKING IN HIGH RISK OR SENSITIVE AREAS

Due to the sensitivity of the work done or the dangerousness of the places in which they work, details on these supported missionaries must be limited.

The Staker Family (TEAM Missionaries): missionaries in the Middle East (country not identified for security reasons) who are introducing the Gospel to Muslim men and women

NG (YWAM Lebanon): a Lebanese missionary serving in a Syrian refugee camp in Lebanon

AA (Nigeria): a Nigerian missionary based in UK for her own safety, leading a ministry producing film and videos highlighting human trafficking victims in Africa

MSN (Myanmar): a Burmese missionary, who disciples villagers in rural Myanmar, leads workshops on primary & dental health care, and provides a safe house for abused girls and women

Agape India: a church-planting & discipleship ministry, providing training and very limited financial support for over 30 pastors and their congregations (all serving in a very high persecution area of India)

C3: domestic ministry providing outreach and community building among Muslims living in the US
